Fire Safety Equipment Building Permit Information Sheet

- 1. Automatic Sprinkler System**-2 sets of plans must show all information listed in the working plans section of the applicable NFPA Standard, include hydraulic calculations, and be stamped & signed by a NYS design professional. See information sheet also.
- 2. Fire Alarm**-NYS license required, 2 sets of plans must include all 11 items in NYSFC 907.1.1
- 3. Commercial Cooking Equipment Suppression System**-see separate information sheet
- 4. Clean Agent Fire Extinguishing System**-see separate information sheet
- 5. Fire Escape**-install, repair, alteration-see separate information sheet
- 6. Standpipe System** **7. Fire Hydrant**-water main
- 8. Fire Pump**
- 9. Fire Department Connections**
- 10. Open Burning**
- 11. Other Fire related** _____

You must submit two (2) detailed, scaled sets of architectural/mechanical plans with all dimensions included.

Drawings must include and clearly show: location of all equipment or appliances (i.e. garage, basement, closet), all dimensions and clearances, all piping (show valves and other equipment), vents, any additional electrical wiring, and location of any other items related to the installation. The Manufacturer's specifications for all equipment or appliances must also be included with the permit application. Some systems or items have additional specific permit submittal requirements that must be met before a review. New York State Code requirements apply to all work. A non-refundable application fee is due before any plan review will occur. Incomplete submittals will delay the permit process. Some of the above items or systems also require a yearly Operating Permit from the Village of New Paltz once installed. See Operating Permit information sheet for requirements.

Rough inspections – before wall or ceiling finishes are applied.
